

This pattern is cross-stitched over two threads of fabric.
Depending on your choice of fabric, use one or two plies of thread. Because these threads have soft subtle shades, make sure to properly realign the plies if you use more than one ply.

After completing the crossstitch section, backstitch (or Holbein stitch) with one ply.


Stitch count: 50 x 50
